

Luke 22:31-34 KJV

[31] And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: [32] But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren. [33] And he said unto him, Lord, I am ready to go with thee, both into prison, and to death. [34] And he said, I tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before that thou shalt thrice deny that thou knowest me.

1. DON'T MISS THE SPIRITUAL DIMENSION IN LIFE

It's easy to get focused on the day-to-day circumstances in life and not see the larger picture of God's purpose for our life. In the daily struggle, God has marked us as his children to grow and learn and satan has marked us as the enemy to shake up and ruin our testimony. satan can't take away our salvation, but he can trick us into losing our joy. satan must always seek God's permission.

2. DON'T FORGET OUR SAVIOR'S INTERCESSION
